Applying for fee concessions in the ACT

Students may apply for Fee concession prior to the commencement of training. They will need to advise the RTO representative during the enrolment session that they wish to apply for a fee concession.

If you would like to apply for a concession fee after your enrolment session, email ask@momentumconsult.com.au attention the Director of Operations.

In order to be eligible for a fee concession students must hold a current and valid form of one of the following:

- a) Health Care Card issued by the Commonwealth;
 - b) Pensioner Concession Card; or
 - c) Veteran's Gold Card; or
 - d) an alternative card or concession eligibility criterion approved by the Minister for the purposes of these Guidelines
- The RTO representative will sight and retains copies of all documentation demonstrating an individual's eligibility for a fee concession for audit or review purposes.

Applying for Tuition Fee Waivers/Exemptions in the ACT

In exceptional circumstances students may apply for fee waiver or exemption prior to the commencement of training, they will need to advise the RTO representative during the enrolment session that they wish to apply for a fee waiver or exemption.

Queensland

User Choice

For all trainees eligible for User Choice funded training from the Queensland Government, the learner is required to pay a **Student contribution fee of \$1.60 per nominal hour**. Nominal hours are determined in consultation with published hours from the Queensland Department of Education, Training and Employment and negotiated with the learner and their employer as part of the Training Plan.

Partial or full exemptions may apply when the trainee meets any of the following criteria. Further details should be sought from Momentum Consulting (Qld) Pty Ltd by calling 0408 135 288 or emailing ask@momentumconsult.com.au.
